written explanation real student's example

- | The monument of the first artificial snow
- | The monument of the first artificial snow is located 1 kilometer northwest of JR Sapporo Station. Follow Main Street north about 300 meters from Clark Hall, past the University Museum, and you will see the monument on the east side in front the Faculty House Trillium.
- | The monument is built of white granite and shaped in a hexagon to resemble a snowy crystal. The monument was chosen as one of the 88th items of Kita-ku history and culture.
- | The monument marks the place where Professor Nakatani Ukichirou of the science department succeeding in making the first artificial snow crystal. That happened on March 12, 1936 after 3 years of research. Professor Nakatani has left the word "snow are letters from heaven".
