

- ◆ During class, your teaching assistants and instructor will grade you. Class points form 45 percent of your grade. Some classes, such as classes with long conversations, are worth more points. If you are absent, then you receive no points for that class period.
- ◆ After class, you will submit your assignments. Your assignments will be graded by your instructor. Assignment points form 45 percent of your grade. Some assignments, such as assignments that ask you to write and say long phrases, are worth more points. Assignments are due by the next class. If you do not submit complete assignments by the deadline, then you receive no points for that deadline.
- ◆ Your final exam forms 10 percent of your grade. Your final exam may be partly oral and partly written. You must take the final exam. If you miss the final exam, then you must see me for a personal interview. If you miss both the final exam and the personal interview, then you fail this course, no matter how many points you earned.
