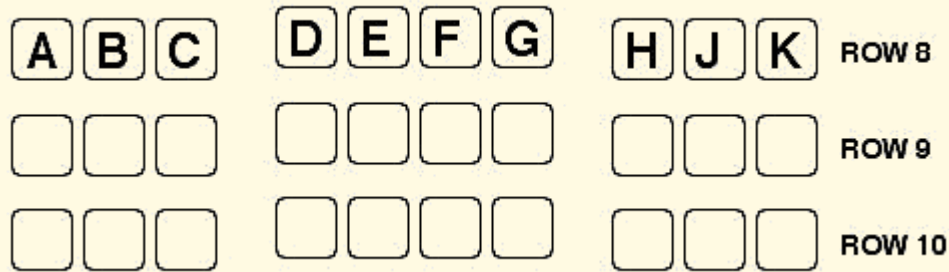

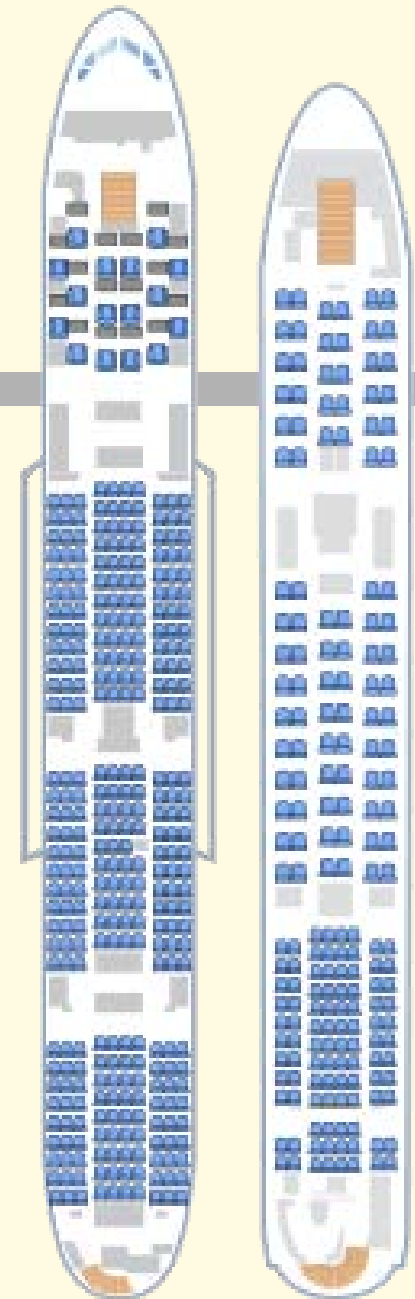

In the 3rd task, you answer questions at any time. In the 1st task, you view subtitles. In the 2nd and 3rd tasks, you view no subtitles.
- 8. Meet the People** -- **Pick 1 task**. The video and questions are the same. The format is different. In the 1st and 2nd tasks, you answer questions as they appear on the screen. In the 3rd task, you answer questions at any time. In the 1st task, you view subtitles. In the 2nd and 3rd tasks, you view no subtitles.
