e.g. Mujhe chaai pasand hai. I like tea.

Aapko ~ pasand hai? Do you like~?

【Greeting】

A: Kya haal hai? How are you?

B: Theek hai. / Accha hai. OK. /Good.

kya---what

【Thanks】

A: Shukriya. /Dhanyavaad. Thank you.

B: Koi baat nahin. No problem.

accha---good

theek---OK

【Other Useful Expressions】

A: Kya hua? What happened?

B: Kuch nahin Nothing.

(Jee) Han ---- Yes

(Jee) Nahin ---- No

A: Aur lijie. Take some more.

B: Bas, bas. I've had enough.

● ~khatam ho gaya. ~ is over. / ~is gone.

● Zaroor. Of course. / Certainly.
